ANOTHER TOOL FOR YOUR DEPLOYMENT KIT

The Army Atlanta Contracting Center (AACC) recently made five awards for an indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity contract titled Logistics Joint Administrative Management Support Services (LOGJAMSS). Covering sixteen task areas encompassing a range of logistics business process reengineering, training, automation, management, and supply and maintenance services. LOGJAMSS combines the best of industries' capabilities with a flexible, responsive and cost effective contract mechanism for services both in CONUS and OCONUS. There is no administrative use fee, and the customer has the option of awarding and administering its own task orders with on-call AACC technical guidance under a delegation of authority, or having AACC award the task order. Offering three separate contract types (firm fixed price, time and materials, and cost plus fixed fee), five prime contractors (ranging from 8(a) certified to small and large businesses), and support by over 40 subcontractors, LOGJAMSS offers the flexibility to sustain power projection for customers throughout the entire Army. Because of up-front pricing provisions, lead times for task order issuance are expected to be 2 to 4 weeks depending on complexity of the requirement and type of contract.

The lack of administrative fee and use of the fair opportunity to compete provisions ensure an economical solution projected to save 6-10% over other contract vehicles currently in use by FORSCOM.

Final awards under LOGJAMSS will be made by the end of March 1999 which will complete the last round of competition.
